**Brunch:** The brunch is your opportunity to connect with fellow presenters. You may set up starting at 10 a.m., then, attend the brunch. You may also bring your materials to the brunch, and we will help you get to your presentation station from there. Please let us know if you plan to attend the brunch in the appropriate section of the enclosed **Equipment Request Form**. If you will not be attending the brunch, please plan on arriving at the museum by 12:00 p.m. Set-up should be completed before 1 p.m.

**Parking:** You may park in the Science Museum's parking ramp and take the elevators **up** to the lobby for check-in at the designated table. There will be staff and volunteers to assist you with unloading and getting to the brunch or to your assigned station.
